AGREED ORDER OF DISMISSAL WITH PREJUDICE

On the 3rd day of Dec., 2019 the Court heard the above styled and numbered case.

Parties

Petitioner, TDFPS appeared in person and by and through their attorney Leslie Odom and have agreed to the Order as evidenced by their signature below

Respondent/Counter Petitioner Daniel Pardo appeared in person and by and through his attorney, Brian Loughmiller, and has agreed to the Order as evidenced by his signature and the signature of his attorney below.

Respondent/Counter Petitioner Ashley Pardo appeared in person and by and through her attorney, Chris Branson, and has agreed to the Order as evidenced by her signature and the signature of her attorney below.

Jurisdiction

The Court finds that it has jurisdiction over the parties, the child and subject matter of the above referenced cause and all parties have been cited to appear herein.

Child and Parties Affected

Findings

The Court finds that Petitioner, TDFPS, and Respondent/Counter Petitioner Daniel Pardo and Ashley Pardo have jointly agreed to dismiss with prejudice all claims asserted in Petitioner's Original Petition for Protection of A Child, For Conservatorship, and For Termination In Suit Affecting Parent Child Relationship, and Respondents/Counter Petitioners' Counter Petitions in Suit Affecting Parent Child Relationship and Motion for Sanctions.

The Court finds that the Dismissal with Prejudice is only to those causes of action plead and counter claims plead in Cause Number 102717-CC currently before the Court.

The Court finds that the designation of TDFPS as Managing Conservator and designation of Daniel Pardo and Ashley Pardo as Possessory Conservators is terminated.

The Court finds that any designation of third parties as individuals or agencies charged with the right and duty to provide informed consent for medical care of Kaleb Pardo is terminated.

The Court finds that Ashley Pardo and Daniel Pardo shall jointly make informed decisions for the medical care and treatment of Kaleb Pardo.

The Court finds that the dismissal of the Original Petition for Protection of A Child, For Conservatorship, and For Termination In Suit Affecting Parent Child Relationship and Counter Petitions in Suit Affecting Parent Child Relationship is in the best interest of the child.

Order

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND DECREED that the Original Petition for Protection of A Child, For Conservatorship, and For Termination In Suit Affecting the Parent Child Relationship as to causes of action cited therein in

Cause number 102717-CC filed by the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services is DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND DECREED that the Counter Claims and Motions for Sanctions in Suit Affecting Parent Child Relationship as to causes of action cited therein in Cause number 102717-CC filed by Respondents/Counter Petitioners Ashley and Daniel Pardo are DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE.

It is ORDERED that all designations of conservatorship pertaining to the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services and Ashley and Daniel Pardo are no longer in effect. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any designation of third parties designated as parties with the right and duty to provide informed consent for medical care of Kaleb Pardo are no longer in effect and are terminated.






